SIX KEYS FOR PRAYING FOR A BREAKTHROUGH

Let God SPEAK TO ME BEFORE I SPEAK TO HIM

² In that first year of his reign, I, Daniel, learned from the book of Jeremiah the prophet that Jerusalem must lie desolate for seventy years.

Focus <u>MY ATTENTION ON GOD</u>
