

THE NAMES OF GOD

The names of God are important because they reveal His character, His essence, and His even His will. Most of God's names are revealed in the Old Testament and speak to the nature of the coming Messiah who we know as Jesus.

- 1. **El Elyon** The Most High or Strongest One (Isaiah 14:13-14)
- 2. El Roi The God Who Sees (Genesis 16:13)
- 3. **El Olam** The Everlasting God (Isaiah 40:28)
- 4. **El Shaddai** The Almighty God (Genesis 17:1-20)
- 5. **Jehovah** (YHWH) –The Self-existent One-(from Exodus 3:14 "I AM WHO I AM") The name Jehovah speaks to relationships between God and His people, and when used emphasizes God's hatred of sin, and love and care of sinners. These are some of the names that Compound with Jehovah:
 - a. Jehovah Jireh The Lord will Provide. (Genesis 22:13-14)
 - b. Jehovah Maccaddeshcem The Lord who Sanctifies you (Exodus 31:13)
 - c. Jehovah Nissi The Lord my Banner. (Exodus 17:15)
 - d. Jehovah Raah The Lord is my Shepherd (Psalms 23:1)
 - e. **Jehovah Rapha** The Lord that Heals (Exodus 15:26)
 - f. **Jehovah Sabboth** The Lord of Hosts (1 Samuel 1:3). The definition of the Hebrew word for hosts means; a mass of persons, as in an army, soldiers, battle, war or warfare. The phrase means therefore The Lord of Warriors/or Warfare.
 - g. Jehovah Shalom The Lord is Peace (Judges 6:24)
 - h. **Jehovah Shammah** The Lord who is There (Ezekiel 48:35)
 - i. **Jehovah Tsidkenu** The Lord our Righteousness (Jeremiah 23:6)
- 6. **Elohim** Strong One
- 7. Adonai Lord or Master

The final Name that is revealed to us, is the New Testament name **Jesus**. The Name of **Jesus** has revealed God as a Savior, and power of His Salvation reaches beyond and above all things.
